
The following guidance is based on 2 different examples, the aim being to guide the user to the relevant volumes depending on the census year and data required.

- Example 2: Occupation figures for Winchester, 1801 to 1931.


Starting point:

Select the tab Browse.



On the left-hand panel select 'Census'.



Select 'Sort by geography'.



On the left-hand panel, click on the 🗎 of 'Great Britain', to expand the options.


- The following census years can be located by expanding 'England': 1841, 1861 to 1931.
- The Viewing Options panel shown below, for the page orientation and zoom facility, will appear at the top left of the screen once you have navigated into one of the census volumes.





Click on 1801 and the associated 1801 volumes will be displayed.




Select 'Enumeration abstract' by clicking on the 'Table of contents'.

Using the 'Next page' option, click to select page 150 where the Parish of Capel can be located at the bottom left of the screen, within the Hundred of Washlingstone.








