Is it possible to have more detailed information for that group (6221) on the all-cause mortality figure for the study period with comparisons from previous years?

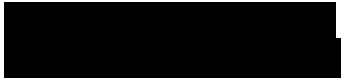
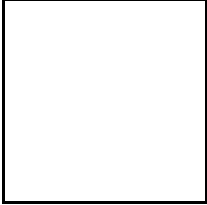
I would like to understand what types of mortality have increased among this cohort.
