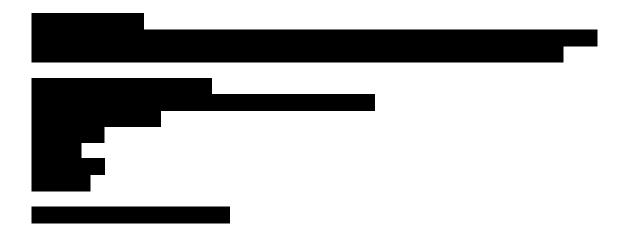

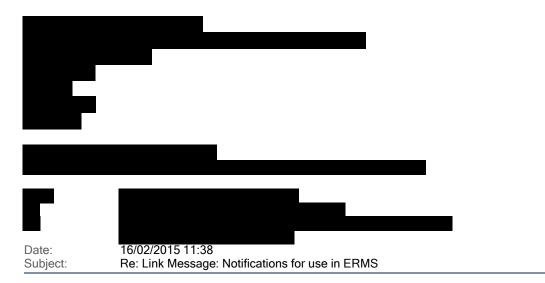

Shall we have a quick natter about this later? My take is we do need the review date displayed in a view.

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Looking at relatively recently declared records I see the following Fields that seem to be relevant, there are two issues here

- 1. We will need to rename these systematically with an agent
- 2. We need to determine how many fields the new system is going to need, in principle fewer is always better, I suggest that the essential fields are
- a. The document is a record
- b. Date record was declared
- c. Who declared it
- d. Category of record

If something can be derived by a program e.g a review date then unless we need to display it in a view then I would rather not have it, the cleverness here is not adding fields, it is economy and anticipation. Generally speaking each extra field should add a considerable amount of processing which is what we don't want and if it doesn't then we need to examine why we need it.

Something else asked for was the text of the notification emails that get sent out.

The linked doc has the mails sent weekly about documents approaching a year old and those sent monthly about declared records needing review.
