I have had a quick search through the code for the word version, it is there 425 times, it doesn't immediately jump out as being connected to ERMS as it doesn't have any code referring to ERMS or KP fields. If versioning only took place with relation to ERMS then I need to remove this I would say.

I have an EDRMS template with the basic framework for how I want to structure the application in UAT and once I have got it refreshed so that it is consistent in its own terms I will send a link - please note what I have developed here is an approach to solving this problem, not implementing the rules etc etc
