All these are fine within around 5% of our estimates EXCEPT the exception is Oxford City where the age profile for the Census 2021 is very different from MYE, particularly for those in their 20s and 30s. On another note, it would be great if we can work with ONS on encouraging GP surgeries to clean up their population figures – we have lots of temporary language school visitors who get registered and mess our figures up!
