I would be grateful if you could provide the 2012 VS tables for the Caerphilly County Borough area only to me at your earliest convenience.

In relation to the proposal to change the geographic level of future releases to MSOA only, this would not be suitable for our needs. MSOA's are not used extensively by local authorities in Wales. We are still required by the Welsh Government to undertake a lot of our service planning/prioritisation at a ward level, and therefore still require our births and deaths data at this level. Many of our wards are smaller than MSOA's so this would reduce the granularity at which we are able to analyse the data. Ward level births data in particular is used extensively by our Education and Social Services departments.

In relation to the proposal to use 2011 Census merged wards or wards I have to admit I have no preference. Thankfully within our borough the geographies are the same, but this will not be the case for all authorities, so they may well have another view.
