Introduction

This publication provides an overview of the Public Sector Finances for UK countries and regions. Under the current constitutional arrangements, most aspects of fiscal policy are controlled by the UK Government, however as there are plans for further devolution in the future there is growing demand for sub-UK statistics. These statistics form part of a collection of regional data produced by ONS to meet such demands.


The underlying data used in this publication are based on various assumptions. Estimates of public sector revenue are based the concept of 'who pays' and apportionment methods, such as the use of surveys, population shares and GVA shares, are used to attribute revenue to the countries and regions of the UK. Estimates of public sector expenditure are based on the concept of 'who benefits', this method attempts to apportion expenditure based on the location of the residents who have benefited from expenditure of a particular department. Most public spending however, is planned to benefit categories of individuals and enterprises irrespective of location, only a minority of public spending is planned on a regional basis.

The figures in this article are to be considered estimates only and may not be an accurate representation of public finances should fiscal powers be fully devolved among UK countries and regions.

These statistics play no part in resource allocation or operation of the Barnett Formula.






Public Sector Revenue

Administrative data for all tax receipts are generally not available at a regional level as such a number of apportionment methods are applied to UK totals to obtain regional breakdowns. The majority of apportionment methods use survey data as the basis for obtaining sub-national splits, other apportionment methods used include splits based on GVA shares as well as population share splits.




Public Sector Expenditure
