## Submit your Census 2021 questionnaire **NOW** to avoid prosecution

Our records show that **you've failed to submit a Census 2021 questionnaire**, either by post or online, despite reminders.

The census in England and Wales is governed by the Census Act 1920. Under this Act, **it's compulsory by law** for every household in England and Wales to complete a census questionnaire.

The Office for National Statistics is now beginning legal proceedings against those who have refused to submit a census form.

## WARNING

You must submit a Census 2021 questionnaire within seven days of receiving this letter. If you do not, your details will be passed to our lawyers and legal proceedings will commence with a possible prosecution. A guilty verdict for non-compliance will result in a **criminal record and a fine of up to £1,000**.
