It was nice to talk with you this afternoon. It would still be helpful to have sight of the draft recommendations to ensure that we fully understand the initial areas of concern and can come prepared to discuss as many of these areas as possible on Monday – and follow-up on others at a later date should we not manage to cover them all in one sitting. Similarly, it would be helpful to see any draft report. This would be helpful to check whether there have been any misunderstandings during the first round of evidence gathering. Some of the issues noted in Rogers email are surprising, so it would be good to check that these have not been brought about by any miscommunication.
